Our process

Upon registration, every group will go through a set up year before operating independently. There are two SmartRivers seasons each year, one in spring and one in autumn.

The next couple of pages demonstrate what the set up year and subsequent years look like.

These processes have been, and will continue to be, carefully refined over time following volunteer and expert feedback.

Confirm sampling logistics and analysis pathway

How many samples will be sent versus self identified by the group? A combined approach is possible and this is flexible each season.

Quality control

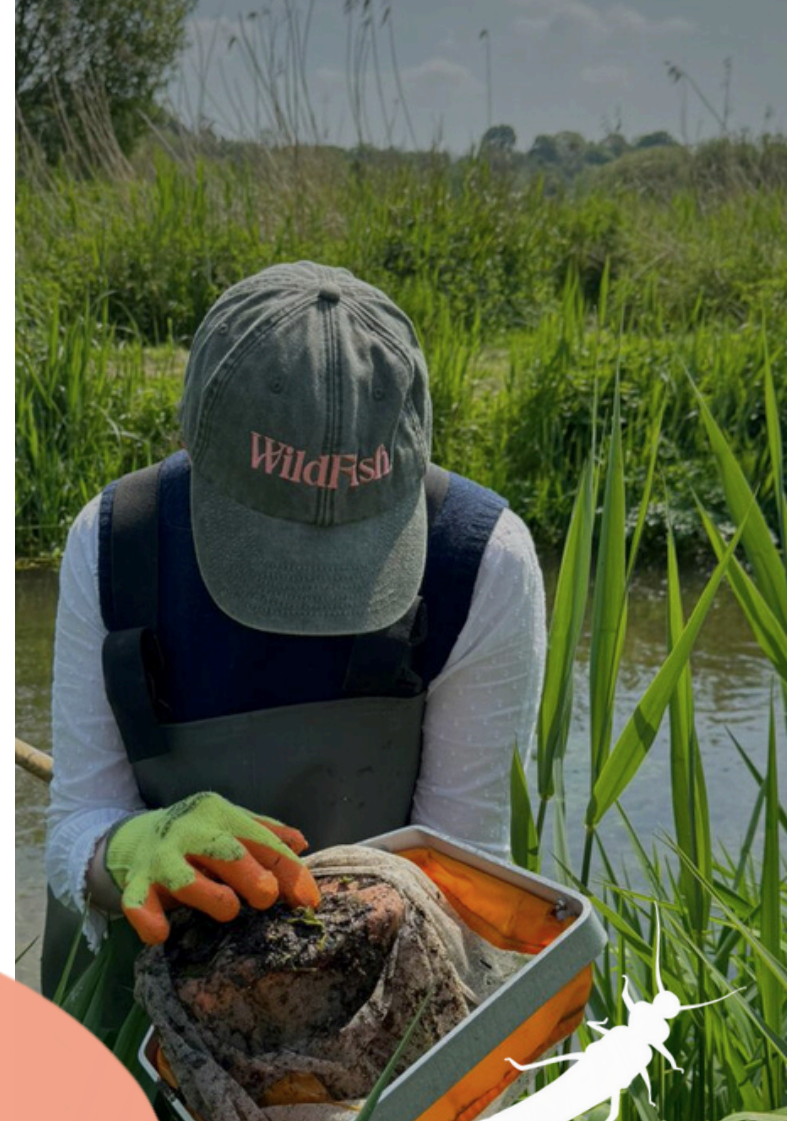
- We choose one QC sample per group each season
- We book collection and delivery
- Analyst sends QC results

Seasonal report produced

Group follow up

- We update [expected species lists](#) twice a year and offer tailored QC feedback to self ID groups
- We can present/explain data outputs to groups if requested
- Sample sites can be adjusted over time

Repeats each season
